

## **Nunzio Guglielmino**

### **Independent Director**

Born in Rome on 14 January 1946, graduated in Law and Political Sciences from the University of Rome. From 1980 to 1984 he was an official at the Ministry of the Treasury and from 1984 to 1993 he covered the role of Councillor for Economic and Monetary Affairs at the Permanent Representation of Italy in Brussels, actively participating at meetings of the Council of Financial Ministers of the European Union (ECOFIN) and contributing to preparing the Maastricht Treaty. From 1993 to 1995 he worked at the Ministry of Economy and Finance and, in 1996, he was appointed General Manager at the Treasury Department of the Ministry of Economy and Finance.

From 1993 to 2000 he was on the Board of Directors of the European Investment Bank and from 2000 to 2015 he was Deputy Governor of the Council of Europe Development Bank (CEB). He was Deputy Chairman of Poste Italiane and Board Director of Cassa Depositi e Prestiti and other companies, both public and private. From October 2016 to 30 June 2018 he held the position of expert advisor for the examination and in-depth analysis of EU law matters, at the Presidency of the Council of Ministers.

He is an independent Board Director of doValue S.p.A., where he chairs the Appointment and Remuneration Committee and was a member of the Risks and Transactions with Related Parties Committee.
